

## Championship Information

### **Format**

A maximum of 20 teams comprising of six players shall compete. All players and teams will play two rounds of stroke play; the lowest five scores from the team of six to count to the team score each day.

The leading eight teams after round two will progress to the first flight of match play, where matches will consist of two foursomes games in the morning and five singles games in the afternoon whilst in medal contention. The next eight teams after round two will progress to the second flight of match play, where matches will consist of one foursomes game and four singles games. The final four teams after round two will progress to the third flight, where matches will consist of one foursomes game and four singles games.

### **Tee Times & Draw**

All tee times will be published in the evening each day prior to each Championship round, and will be published online and on official noticeboards at Conwy Golf Club and the Imperial Hotel:

- Shortly after 17.00hrs for the stroke play stages
- 30 minutes after the completion of the stroke play stages/previous day's match for the match play stages

### **Registration**

Federations and Unions must submit player's names to Wales Golf no later than Thursday 23rd June. On-site registration at Conwy Golf Club will open from 8.00am on July 3 and close at 12.00 noon on July 4; team captains may register teams on behalf of the players.

### **Practice Rounds**

All practice rounds on the official practice days will be at assigned times by the EGA. Players are to play one ball only; except players may play additional shots when:

- They have missed the green (one additional shot only)
- Where the Rules of Golf apply
- Chipping, putting or bunker play around the green provided play is not delayed.

### **Practice**

Balls for the grass practice range and chipping greens will be provided. Players may use their own golf balls on the chipping and/or putting greens if they wish.

### **Trolleys**

Pull trolleys will be provided for all competitors. Electric trolleys will not be available for hire, but may be used if players provide their own.

### **Course Planners**

Championship Planners will be available for all competitors. Teams should specify if they would like distances in meters or yards on the travel and accommodation form.

## Transfers and Shuttle Service

### Arrivals

Upon arrival into Manchester, and once successfully completed passport control and reclaimed luggage, Wales Golf staff will have a meeting area in the arrivals zone of Terminal 1. Manchester's three terminals are very conveniently close to each other, so should your flight arrive at a different terminal you can walk easily to terminal 1. If you are unable to find the Wales Golf Team, please ring Laurie Evans on +44 7464 600458.

Coach transfers are booked to cover the travel plans of all teams; some players and staff may experience a small delay in the arrivals lounge. An account will be setup with the Wales Golf team to cover any refreshments you may need to stay comfortable.

There will be a water cooler located by the Recording Office, near to the 1st and 11th tee. Players are welcome to fill water bottles when required. There will also be two hand water pumps located at tee 6 and tee 15. Bananas will also be provided on tees 1 and 11.

Additional refreshments can also be obtained from the professional shop and from the clubhouse.

### **Internet**

Players and staff are welcome to use the Internet available at the golf club. Wi-Fi codes will be displayed on site at Conwy Golf Club.

The Imperial Hotel provides internet as standard for all guests.

### **Live Scoring & Leaderboards**

Live scores will be taken every 3 holes throughout the Championship. There are on-course leaderboards after holes 3, 6, 9, 10, 12 and 15 which will display the most current relevant information.

Links to online live scores and results will be published onsite at the Championship Office.

### **Locker Rooms**

There are locker rooms at Conwy Golf Club which are free to be used by all competitors and team staff. Shower facilities at the club are available for use. Each team will be assigned and have the use of a locker at the club.

### **Bag Stores**

There is no bag store facility at the host club; competitors will be required to take their clubs back to their rooms each day.

### **Catering**

The kitchen will be open at Conwy Golf Club one hour before first tee time through to the close of play. Additionally, breakfast will be available and included at the Official Hotel.

Teams will have exclusive use of the dining room at the golf club throughout the Championship. There will be a special menu in place; any specific dietary requirements or allergies can be included in the team list or directly with the club upon arrival.

All teams will have access to an account for food and beverage, which they must clear prior to the end of the Championship on the 9th July.

### **Dress Code**

The dress code for the Championship is smart casual standard golf attire. National Team Formal attire for the Opening & Closing Ceremonies, and the Gala Dinner. There is no dress code in the official hotel.

### **Team Rooms**

Team rooms for meetings can be booked at the official hotel; they will be on a first come first served basis.
