ALLIANZ COURSE BY ROBERT TRENT JONES SR.

COURSE PRESENTATION - Par 72-5763 meters/6302 yards

Royal Park I Roveri is an exclusive Club just 20 km from the centre of Turin and 10 km from Caselle Airport. It enjoys a unique and characteristic position, surrounded by the Alps and set within La Mandria Regional Park, the Savoia's old game reserve, not far from Reggia di Venaria Reale royal palace. Founded in 1971 by the Agnelli family, it has maintained its defining qualities: professionalism and courtesy in a charming and welcoming atmosphere.

The Allianz Course was designed in 1971, the year the Club was founded, by architect Robert Trent Jones Senior, renowned all around the world for the ability with which he harmonically sets golf courses in their natural surroundings.

Seamlessly blending with La Mandria Regional Park, the course is defined by an innovative style of bunkers and water obstacles, and by the position of its greens and hazards, which encourage the adoption of a more careful game strategy.

the course has been in the top Italian ranking for years and has won numerous international awards throughout its history. it was also the venue of 4 Italian open and national and international championship.



Robert Trent Jones Sr. (June 20, 1906 – June 14, 2000) was an English-American golf course architect who designed or re-designed more than 500 golf courses in 45 U.S. states and 35 countries. In reference to this, Jones took pride in saying, "The sun never sets on a Robert Trent Jones golf course." He is often confused with the famous amateur golfer Bobby Jones with whom he worked from time to time. Jones received the 1987 Old Tom Morris Award from the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America, GCSAA's highest honor. Also in 1987, he was inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame. In Italy he designed some golf courses including the Allianz course in 1971. 4 Italian open and numerous national and international championships were held on this course.

HOW TO GET THERE

THE NEAREST RECOMMENDED AIRPORT IS TORINO-CASELLE AIRPORT

From Torino-Caselle airport, take a taxi (price around 50), or you can rent a car or use uber black.

Out of the airport follow the indication "ciriè"

When you arrive at "ciriè", follow the indication "robassomero" than "royal park I roveri".

If you use navigation system set "via lanzo 1 - robassomero"

In the main entry you will find a big gate with a security check



NEARBY ATTRACTIONS

TORINO / TURIN

Turin is the capital city of Piedmont in northern Italy, known for its refined architecture and cuisine. The Alps rise to the northwest of the city. Stately baroque buildings and old cafes line Turin's boulevards and grand squares such as Piazza Castello and Piazza San Carlo. Nearby is the soaring spire of the Mole Antonelliana, a 19th-century tower housing the interactive National Cinema Museum.

LA VENARIA REALE

La Venaria Reale is a grandiose estate just outside Turin. It comprises 80,000 square meters of floor surface in the Reggia and 60 hectares of Gardens, adjacent to the 17th century ancient village of Venaria and the 3,000 fenced hectares of the Park of La Mandria. It is a natural and architectural masterpiece that was declared part of the World Heritage by UNESCO in 1997. It reopened to the public in 2007 after completing the EU's largest cultural restoration project to date.

The monumental palace, is home to some of the finest examples of universal Baroque: the enchanting Hall of Diana designed by Amedeo di Castellamonte, the breathtaking Great Gallery and the solemn Church of St. Hubert, the grandiose complex of the Juvarra Stables designed by Filippo Juvarra in the 18th century, the sumptuous decorations, the famous Bucentaur and the spectacular Fountain of the Stag in the Court of Honor.

These provide a unique setting for the Theater of History and Magnificence, the permanent display – almost 2,000 m long – devoted to the House of Savoy, that spans from the basement level to the piano nobile of the Reggia.

Prizes

The winner of the Championship shall be the European Ladies' Amateur Champion Golfer for a period of one year. The Championship Trophy shall be kept by the European Golf Association. The Organising Committee will return the Trophy to the

EGA Office who will be responsible for engraving and maintaining it. The winner shall receive a gold medal, the runner up a silver medal and the third-placed competitor a bronze medal.

Cut

The 60 lowest scores over the first 54 holes, including ties, shall qualify for the final 18 holes.

If a competitor, who has posted a three-round total that will qualify for the final round, withdraws before or after the final round draw is made, the competitor's results will still be used to calculate the leading 60 places and ties that will determine the cut mark.
