Championship Course St. Leon

Course St. Leon was designed by the English architect Dave Thomas in the style of a links course. The feel of the course is reminiscent of those found in Scotland and Ireland. If you are used to rather flat parkland courses you will certainly perceive St. Leon's lush, undulating greens and fairways as challenge.

If that is not enough, the ubiquitous water hazards and lakes both around the greens and alongside the fairways are constant threat to stray balls. An impressive feature of St. Leon are its artistically shaped and sometimes gigantic bunkers, whose strategic positioning provides not only excellent protection to the greens but also makes for narrow and challenging fairways.

General Information

Anti Doping

A player shall not knowingly make use of a drug to enhance his performance. In this respect, the attention of players is drawn to the prescribed list of drugs issued by the host country's national sports council. Any player breaching these conditions or refusing to make a test may be disqualified.

Club and Golf Bag Storage

Golf bags can be stored at own risk in the caddie-house next to the clubhouse.

Credit Cards

Payment of expenses at the hotel and golf club can be made by credit card.

Dinner

On Monday, Thursday and Saturday, the Golf Club St. Leon-Rot offers evening catering for the tournament participants and those responsible.

On the remaining days you can eat in the restaurant at the Golf-Club on self-pay basis. At the first restaurant visit, the catering can create a team account per nation, which is then paid collectively by a team member on the last day of the tournament.

In addition, there is a bakery, a pizzeria and the Wok Kitchen nearby, which can be easily reached by foot.

Driving Clubs

Any driver the player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by R&A. Penalty for making a stroke with club in Breach of Condition: Disqualification.



General Information

Locker rooms

Available in the clubhouse from 6:00 am. Access only with code, available at check in. Keys will be handed out during registration. A deposit of 20€ is required. Please note that smoking is not permitted in the changing rooms and toilets.

Medical Service

Medical Service will be provided during the whole Championship.

Germany - Rhine-Neckar Area

Heidelberg is a city in Baden-Württemberg in south-west Germany, situated on the Neckar. The city is known for the picturesque old town with the castle ruins and for the renowned university, the oldest university in Germany. It attracts scientists and visitors from all over the world.

With almost 160,000 inhabitants, Heidelberg is the fifth largest city in Baden-Württemberg and the 52nd largest city in Germany. The densely populated Rhine-Neckar area, in which Heidelberg is located along with the cities of Mannheim and Ludwigshafen am Rhein, is known as the Rhine-Neckar metropolitan region.

Climate of the Rhine-Neckar Area

The climate in the sheltered location is mild all year round. Compared to the nearby Rhine plain, Heidelberg's location at the exit of the Neckar Valley causes an above-average frequency of east-winds. The warmest month is July with an average of 20.1 °C, temperatures above 30 °C are not uncommon in midsummer. Most precipitation also falls in July.
