MESSAGE FROM THE GOLF DE CHIBERTA PRESIDENT



Between Ocean and Forest, Tradition and Modernity

A recent ranking by golf professionals places Chiberta among the top 15 French courses every golfer should play at least once. This distinction is especially remarkable since Chiberta is an associative golf club. It shows that a non-commercial sports association run by volunteers can be excellently managed, recruit top teams, and achieve excellence while remaining accessible to a wide and diverse audience in a friendly environment.

The Chiberta Grand Prix, which hosts top amateur golfers from France and abroad over four days, demonstrates the efficiency of its volunteers on a course that blends tradition and modernity. The tradition lies in respecting the layout designed in 1927 by the eccentric British architect Tom Simpson, who also designed the courses at Morfontaine, Fontainebleau, and Chantilly. The course is playable in all weather due to its sandy soil, featuring links with spectacular views of the Basque Coast and a century-old pine forest.

Modernity is reflected in Chiberta being a pilot site for adapting to climate change. The course experiments with new grass combinations resistant to pests, diseases, heat, and drought, replaces chemical treatments with biostimulants or biocontrol, and uses artificial intelligence to detect and manage diseases. The irrigation system is fully computer-controlled based on weather conditions.

The 13-member maintenance team works year-round to implement the French Golf Federation's standards for firmness, homogeneity, and green speed, reflecting the club's commitment to hosting significant sporting events. It's no surprise that the EGA and the FFG chose Chiberta for the inaugural mid-amateur team competition.

Competitors will have a brand-new practice area to hone their swings. Despite its modest par (70), the course's deep bunkers, narrow greens, deceptive slopes, and potentially challenging wind demand precision. Notable champions like Jean Garaialde, José Maria Olazábal, and Severiano Ballesteros have trained at Chiberta.

Players might also be intrigued to know they follow in the footsteps of Sean Connery, the Scottish actor who famously portrayed James Bond and visited Chiberta with his family incognito.

Tradition and modernity, indeed.

TEAM FEE

The team fee to be paid directly to the French Golf Federation is €800 per team. It covers transfers between the official airport and the official hotel, practice balls, pull trolleys, yardage books, team photographs, and social events (for 4 players and a captain).

The participation fee for additional individuals traveling with the teams is €200 per person. It covers transfers between the official airport and the official hotel, as well as social events. This fee will be paid together with the team fee.

REGISTRATION

Registration is open on Monday 9th and Tuesday 10th September.

Participating teams are requested to register at the Club House immediately upon arrival.

Failure to register or to notify the Committee in advance of arrival time may result in the team losing its reserved starting field place.

PRIZES

Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the teams placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in both the men's and women's rankings, respectively.



DRESS CODE

A reasonable standard of golf clothes (no jeans, no t-shirts, bermuda shorts permitted) is required at all times on the course and in the clubhouse. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course.

TROLLEYS

Manual golf trolleys are available for free.

LOCKER ROOMS

A locker will be provided for each team.

BAG STORAGE

A golf bag storage service is available at the club.

TRANSPORTATION

Shuttles will be organized between Biarritz Pays Basque airport and the official hotel on arrival (9 September) and departure (15 September) days.

As the official hotel is located directly on the golf course, there is no shuttle service during the championship days (except for officials from the committees accommodated in another hotel).

CATERING

Breakfast is served in the hotel.

Lunches with a varied menu are served in the clubhouse restaurant.

Price range: from €17 to €28.

Dinners can be booked at the hotel.

Some other restaurants are within a 15-minute walk.

Water stations and fruits will be available at the 1st and 10th tees. Players are encouraged to bring their own water bottles. Plastic bottles can be purchased at the golf restaurant.







AIRPORT

The official airport is Biarritz Pays Basque airport (BIQ). It is located 14 minutes (6.5 km) from the golf course.

The number of rooms is limited. Reservations for players are based on 2 twin rooms, and only one additional room per nation is allowed. Extra rooms will be allocated subject to availability and on first come first serve basis.

- Tourist tax: €3,46 per day per person

Prices include breakfast.
